

Thank you for raising awareness about the Gaza blockade! Here's how it works:

- **1.** Print the PDF on 18" × 24" sturdy poster board.
- **2.** Bring stickers or markers for people to answer the questions directly on the poster.
- 3. Review information on gazaunlocked.org and print copies of the handout at gazaunlocked.org/strawberry to give to people you talk with.
- **4.** Start a conversation—at farmers' markets, Meeting, conferences, summer fairs, family reunions, or any place.
 - Let people know that you are a volunteer with AFSC.
 - Tell them that their responses are confidential, anonymous, and voluntary.
 - Anyone is free to stop participating or leave at any time.
 - · Listen.

- **5.** Ask people to mark their answers on the poster.
 - If a person has questions and comments, write them down.
 Whatever people say (or don't say) is ok.
 - Participants should feel free to ask questions of you before and after noting their answers on the poster.
- **6.** Share the handout and send people to **gazaunlocked.org** for more information.
- Take pictures! Share on social media, tag @AFSC_org, and use the hashtag #GazaUnlocked.
- **8.** Send us the responses. Email a picture of your poster to **research@afsc.org**.

Thank you for your time! The posters help us assess what people know and don't know about Gaza.
